Academic and Special Area Classes

The Arlington Baptist H.O.M.E. Tutorial (ABHT) is a support ministry for parents who have elected to instruct their children at home.

- ABHT offers once or twice a week classes for home schooled children in grades 2nd through 12th
- ABHT offers academic and special area classes
- ABHT offers classes taught by ABS teachers in the day school with both ABS students and home schooled students in the classes
- ABHT offers classes taught by private tutors to just home schooled students

The Arlington Baptist H.O.M.E. Tutorial is open to **ALL** home schooling families.

- You do not have to be enrolled in the H.O.M.E. Program in order to take classes in the ABS H.O.M.E. Tutorial taught by private tutors.
- However, it is required to be in the H.O.M.E. Program if you are interested in enrolling in the Virtual School, taking classes in the Arlington Baptist Day School, playing on Arlington's sports teams or participating in the Fine Arts Program.

The Arlington Baptist H.O.M.E. Tutorial offers **academic classes** for grades 3rd through 12th

- Academic classes are held twice a week for the school year.
- These classes generally include: English, Math, Science, History, Bible, Speech, and Foreign Language; depending on the grade level.

The Arlington Baptist H.O.M.E. Tutorial offers **special area classes** for grades 2nd through 12th

- Special Area classes are held once or twice a week for the school year.
- These classes generally include: Computer, Music, Band, Bells, Choir, Art, Elementary Spanish, Physical Education, and Yearbook, depending on the grade level.

The Arlington Baptist H.O.M.E. Tutorial is open to **ALL** home schooling families for **registration**. Registration will take place from April 1st through August 18th or until classes are full.

Tuition and Registration for Academic and Special Area Classes

A non-refundable registration fee is due with tuition payment when registering for classes. Checks should be made payable to Arlington Baptist School with **H.O.M.E. Tutorial** in the memo section.

- Tuition for Academic Class: \$380 per student / per class / per year
- Tuition for Special Area Class: Varies, generally \$170 per student / per class DAY / per year
- Registration Fee: \$0 per student / per class / per year for H.O.M.E. students
- Registration Fee: \$30 per student / per class / per year for students NOT enrolled in HOME (Maximum family fee \$250)

Registration Procedures for Academic and Special Area Classes

1. Contact the HOME Director for a Tutorial Handbook. Eallen@arlingtonbaptist.org.
2. Commit to adhere to the guidelines as specified in the Tutorial Handbook
3. Fill out a HOME Tutorial Student Registration Information Sheet
4. Decide on the class or classes / academic and / or special area
5. Fill out a registration form for the selected classes
6. Sign a Tutorial Student Conduct Form
7. Fill out a Medical Waiver Form
8. Sign the Student and Parent Agreement Forms
9. Obtain the necessary supplies and books for each class
10. Plan on attending the "Back to School Night" on August 18th @ 7:00 PM
11. Mail the Student HOME Tutorial Information Form, Class Registration Form, Student Conduct Form, Medical Waiver Form, Student & Parent Agreement Forms and fees to ABS.

Payments

If you are unable to pay in full at the time of registration, the following payment plan is available:

Total Tuition is paid in 9 monthly installments.

The first monthly installment is paid directly to ABS along with your \$30 registration fee (if applicable) at the time of registration. Make your check payable to Arlington Baptist School with "HOME Tutorial" in the memo line.

The remaining 8 installments are due on the 20th of each month beginning September 20, 2011 and ending April 20, 2012. These payments are processed through FACTS Tuition Management Company and are made by automatic transfer from your checking or savings account, or by automatic charge to your American Express, Discover or MasterCard. An annual fee of \$38.00 will be automatically charged up front to your checking, savings, or credit card account. Those choosing this payment option should contact the Business Office for details and complete an Automatic Tuition Payment Agreement before August 29, 2011. (410-655-9300, ext 126)

Mondays “Little Bit of Everything”

Grades 2nd – 5th from 3:30 – 4:30 PM

Students will create with a variety of mediums such as (but not limited to) oil pastels, chalk pastels, watercolors, acrylic paint, and clay. We will explore a variety of disciplines like drawing, painting, printmaking, mosaics, and sculpture. Subject matter will include people, animals, buildings, landscapes, seascapes, still life, and abstract forms. Styles from traditional to expressive will be implemented. We will take quick peeks at other artists' work, become familiar with basic color theory and art terms such as in the elements and principles of design.

Wednesdays “Little Bit of Everything”

Grades 6th – 12th from 3:30 – 4:30 PM

Students will work with similar mediums, disciplines and subject matter as mentioned for the 2nd - 5th grade course, except the goals and applications will be more challenging.

Students will have the option to do a weekly, at home, sketchbook assignment that will focus on building drawing and shading skills. I will be happy to look at these and offer comments for improvement. For this I recommend a spiral bound sketchbook.
