**CLASS TITLE: DRAMA: PLAY PRODUCTION**

**GRADE LEVEL: MIDDLE AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

**CLASS TEXT: BASIC DRAMA PROJECTS 8<sup>th</sup> EDITION**

**CLASS DESCRIPTION:** This course provides students with the opportunity to learn and develop specific skills and techniques required to produce exciting and vibrant theater. Based on the idea that theater is a community art form and that a successful play depends upon the cooperation among all members of the production ensemble, this course emphasizes the concept of “The Company” and stresses attitude, sensitivity and creativity as integral elements of the play production experience. Organized in a logical, step-by-step manner, this course follows a production schedule with activities appropriate to each phase of play production. All projects involve class members in group or individual participation: pantomimes, improvisations, monologues, extemporaneous talks, scene development, discussions and play performances.

During the school year, students will create a portfolio that includes original poetry, short stories, monologues and plays that compel their audiences to think about and question the human experience. Students will be given the opportunities to enter local and national writing competitions throughout the school year. If you are the next greatest writer or if you just enjoy creative expression then Poetry, Prose and Play Writing is the course for you!

CLASS DESCRIPTION: As a language course, the students will develop basic communication skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Nouns, pronouns, adjectives, correct sentence structure, and present tense verb conjugation will be strongly focused upon with basic conversing. Fun Spanish games, grammar, and vocabulary activities will be played. Spanish songs will be introduced. Students will be given a chance to discuss Latin American and Spanish movies that will be shown in class. CLASS DESCRIPTION: Spanish level II will be a more advanced, rigorous course in developing communication skills in listening, reading, and writing. Speaking in Spanish will be strongly enforced. Level II will build upon learning more present and past tense verb conjugations, nouns, pronouns, and adjectives. Correct sentence structure will be strongly focused upon for conversing. Spanish games, grammar, and vocabulary activities will also be played.

**HONORS OPTION**

CLASS DESCRIPTION: This option must be decided upon by the first two weeks of class in order to receive Honor’s credit. Students who choose this option will do all of the regular Spanish II assignments plus read a Spanish fictional adventure book and complete additional assignments. The book will include both familiar and unfamiliar words and expressions. There will also be extra vocabulary to learn. These vocabulary words will be recycled throughout the course as the students become familiar with reading other Spanish material outside of the classroom. New Spanish songs will also be introduced as well as basic religious terminology and vocabulary.

**CLASS TITLE: ART**

**GRADE LEVEL: 2<sup>ND</sup> – 5<sup>TH</sup> AND 6<sup>TH</sup> – 12<sup>TH</sup>**

**CLASS DESCRIPTION:** Students will register for 1 semester at a time. All classes meet for 1 hour once a week. Classes are held in the high school **art room #107**, which is located in the high school building behind the church. Students need only bring a smock or old shirt. This may be left in the art room (please write students name on it). The cost for each session is \$70 plus a \$40 supply fee (\$110).

**Mondays** “Little Bit of Everything”

Grades 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 – 4:30 PM

Students will create with a variety of mediums such as (but not limited to) oil pastels, chalk pastels, watercolors, acrylic paint, and clay. We will explore a variety of disciplines like drawing, painting, printmaking, mosaics, and sculpture. Subject matter will include people, animals, buildings, landscapes, seascapes, still life, and abstract forms. Styles from traditional to expressive will be implemented. We will take quick peeks at other artists' work, become familiar with basic color theory and art terms such as in the elements and principles of design.

**Wednesdays** “Little Bit of Everything”

Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 – 4:30 PM

Students will work with similar mediums, disciplines and subject matter as mentioned for the 2<sup>nd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grade course, except the goals and applications will be more challenging. Students will have the option to do a weekly, at home, sketchbook assignment that will focus on building drawing and shading skills. I will be happy to look at these and offer comments for improvement. For this I recommend a spiral bound sketchbook.

COST: \$260 PER STUDENT/ PER YEAR (Plus lab fee)

CLASS DESCRIPTION: From the brain in your head to the nails on your toes, you and your students will encounter fascinating facts, engaging activities, intriguing experiments, and loads of fun as you learn about the human body and how to keep it working well. Beginning with a brief history of medicine and a peek into cells and DNA, your students will voyage through fourteen lessons covering many subjects, such as the body systems: skeletal, muscular, respiratory, digestive, cardiovascular, nervous and more! They'll study nutrition and health, how God designed their immune system to protect them, along with embryology and what makes them a unique creation of God. As they work their way through the course, your students will enjoy adding the organs about which they learn to their own personalized human figure to be placed in their course notebook. In addition to all this exploration, your students will enjoy scientific experiments and projects, such as testing the bacteria content around the house, finding their blood type, creating a cell model from Jell-O and candy, and even building a stethoscope!
